## Categories and Products

### Category Node

To add a category to your shop right click the “Catalog” node and click “Create”. Name the category for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself.

There are 2 types of tabs: “Global” and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the **Global tab** you can choose an image to show up with the category.

The other tabs are named after the different shop-languages. Fill in the name for the category in each of the language tabs.

You can publish a category node without products. The category will show in your shop, but will have a “no products” message.

You can create an unlimited number of categories.

### Product Node

To add a product to your shop right click the category node you want to add the product to and click “create”. Name the product for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself.

There are 3 types of tabs: “Global”, “Custom” and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the **Global tab** you can select the product images and product downloads related to the product. When no product image is chosen, a “no-image” image will be displayed with the product.

In the **Custom tab** you can fill in custom fields that will render on the product page. By default there is a “manufacturer” input.

The other tabs are named after the different shop-languages. Each has it’s own product Name, Short Description and Full description.

An unlimited number of products can be created.

### Pricing Node

To add pricing to a product right click the product node you want to add the pricing to and click “create”. Name the pricing for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself.

There are 2 types of tabs: “Custom” and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the **Custom tab** you can fill in custom fields that will render on the product page, by default there are “article number” and “product number” inputs.

The other tabs are named after the different shop-languages. Each has its own Product Name (*for example: One Item, White Version, Bundle of 10*), Price Description, Price without VAT/TAX and a Tax dropdown.

The price field is the price of the item in the currency for the country of the tab. *For example, in the US tab, enter the amount in US-dollars, in the UK tab enter the amount in UK Pounds, and in the NL tab enter the amount in Euro.*

There is no limitation to the amount of prices connected to a product.

### Sales

To create a sale right click the “Sales” node and choose “create”. Name the sale for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself.

There are 2 types of tabs: “Products” and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the **Products tab**, specify the product, or products (when using uComponents) this sale applies to.

The other tabs are named after the different shop-languages. Each has its own sale for the chosen product(s). You can enable a sale for each language; give the sale a title and a description. Then add a discount percentage or amount. The sale will automatically be applied to the products.

## Shipping Zones & Shipping Providers

### Shipping Zones

Shipping zones can be created to define specific shipping costs to specific shipping zones.

To create a shipping zone right click the “Shipping Zones” folder under “Shipping” and click “create”. Name the shipping zone for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself. Choose the “SSWS – Shipping Zone” document type.

The Shipping Zone node contains a country selector. Countries on the left are not included. Move countries to the right using the arrows to include them in the Shipping Zone.

### Shipping Providers

Shipping Providers can be created to connect shipping costs to a shipping area with a specified provider who will take care of the shipping.

To create a shipping provider right click the “Shipping Providers” folder under “Shipping” and click “create”. Name the shipping provider for recognition. This name will not be shown in the shop itself. Choose the “SSWS – Shipping Provider” document type.

There are 2 types of tabs: “Global” and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the **Global tab** you can choose the shipping zone this shipping costs and shipping provider applies to.

Define the range of amount of items this shipping cost will be applied to (for example: 0 to 100). If this shipping provider is not shipping out, but a store pick-up, check the “this provider is no delivery provider” checkbox.

For each **language tab** you can define the name of the shipping provider and the costs.

The shipping costs field is the price of the shipping to the chosen shipping zone countries’ in the currency for the country of the tab including tax.

*For example, in the US tab, enter the amount in US-dollars, in the UK tab enter the amount in UK Pounds, and in the NL tab enter the amount in Euro.*

## E-Mail Templates

There are different mails for various stages in the order process and when a customer creates an account.

There are 2 types of tabs: "Global" and a tab for each language in the shop.

In the global tab you can choose the type of e-mail.

For each language tab you can define the content of the e-mail.

There is a set of replacement tags available per e-mail type to use.

### Order Confirmation Customer e-Mail

- #FIRSTNAME# - Display the customers first name.
- #JOINNAME# - Display the customers join name.
- #LASTNAME# - Display the customers last name.
- #ORDERNUMER# - Display the customers order number
- #ORDERDETAILS# - Display the customer order details (products/pricing)
- #SHIPPINGINFO# - Display the shipping provider chosen
- #ORDERNOTAX# - Display the order amount excluding tax
- #ORDERTOTAL# - Display the order amount including tax

### Account Creation e-mail

- #EMAILADDRESS# - Display the customer username/e-mail address
- #PASSWORD# - Display the generated password

### Payment Success e-mail & Payment Failed e-mail

- #FIRSTNAME# - Display the customers first name.
- #JOINNAME# - Display the customers join name.
- #LASTNAME# - Display the customers last name.
- #ORDERNUMER# - Display the customers order number
- #ORDERDETAILS# - Display the customer order details (products/pricing)
- #SHIPPINGINFO# - Display the shipping provider chosen
- #ORDERNOTAX# - Display the order amount excluding tax
- #ORDERTOTAL# - Display the order amount including tax

## **Payment Providers**

SuperSimpleWebshop makes it possible to connect an unlimited number of payment providers to one shop.

Payment providers can be created using the SuperSimpleWebshop API.

### **Payment Provider**

To create a Payment Providers right click “Payment Providers” and choose “create”.

The name of the payment provider is defined by the name of the payment provider part in the dll name.

By default a payment provider module is named:

SuperSimpleWebshop.Payment.PaymentProviderName.dll

The name of the Payment Provider node should then be: PaymentProviderName.

There are two options to choose from.

### **Payment Provider Type**

There are tree choices in payment provider types:

1. SSWS Payment Provider  
Choose this option when the payment provider is an external provider.
2. Payment Upon Pickup  
Choose this option when the payment has to be made when the customer comes to your store. This option removes the online payment button after the transaction.
3. Payment Upon Delivery  
Choose this option when the payment has to be made when the product is delivered to the customer. This option removes the online payment button after the transaction.

In most cases the choice will be option 1. De default “PickUp” provider in the SuperSimpleWebshop package uses option 2.

### **Payment Macro**

If there is communication with an external server for the specified payment provider, the “SSWS – PaymentHandler” macro is to be chosen.

## Settings

There is a minimum of settings for SuperSimpleWebshop.

There are 2 types of tabs: "Global" and an "E-Mail" tab.

In the *Global tab* can be defined which image will be shown when a product doesn't have an image.

There is also the option to define a prefix for the order numbers.

In the *E-Mail tab* the e-mail address from which the shop will send e-mails must be defined.
